AIRPORT ROADWAY REALIGNMENT PROJECT UNDERWAY

<u>Project to Smooth Traffic Flow</u> <u>From Inbound Airport Tunnel to Departures Area</u>

Construction is underway on a roadway realignment project at McCarran International Airport aimed at smoothing traffic flow for travelers coming into the airport as they make their way to the "departures" area.

The project will involve the reconfiguration of landscaped areas and storm drains, as well as the realignment of road sections leading from the I-215/airport connector tunnel to the departures curb, easing sharp turns and improving roadway access for travelers.

The project is anticipated for completion by January, 2002. During the construction period, drivers are asked to exercise caution and slow down as they proceed through affected areas. In addition, non-airport-bound drivers are asked to stay to the right as they exit the northbound tunnel and utilize the airport bypass road.
