LAS Racing Toward a Busy November

Harry Reid International Airport (LAS) is gearing up to welcome the world to Las Vegas for the second Formula 1 Las Vegas Grand Prix scheduled for November 21-23. Here are some essential travel tips for those using the airport during this exciting period:

Count down with the 4-3-2-1 Plan

To ensure a smooth departure after the event, follow this simple timeline:

- **4 Hours Before Departure:** Arrange transportation to the airport or return your rental car.
- **3 Hours Before Departure:** Check your bags with your airline.
- **2 Hours Before Departure:** Join the line at the security checkpoint.
- **1 Hour Before Departure:** Arrive at your gate and be ready to board.

Road Closures and Traffic

- **Proximity:** LAS is just two miles from the racetrack, and race-related road closures may affect access to the airport.
- **Stay Informed:** Sign up for text alerts on F1 road closures by texting "F1LV" to 31996.
- **Allow Extra Travel Time:** Anticipate increased traffic as detours may lead to longer travel times.
- **Avoid Airport Roadways:** If you're not heading to the airport, consider alternate routes.
- **Transportation Options:** Rideshare and taxi services will be in high demand, so plan accordingly.

- **Security Guidelines:** Familiarize yourself with TSA policies by visiting [tsa.gov](https://www.tsa.gov) or reaching out via X/Twitter [@AskTSA](https://twitter.com/AskTSA) or Facebook Messenger at [fb.com/AskTSA](https://www.facebook.com/AskTSA).
- **Mobile Check-In:** Use mobile check-in with your airline to save time.
- **Remote Bag Drop:** Avoid potential lines at airline ticket counters by checking bags and printing boarding passes at either of the two free remote bag-drop locations. The Airport Rent-A-Car Center bag drop is open from 4 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Thursdays through Mondays. Terminal 3 Departures bag drop is open from 4 a.m. to Noon, Thursdays through Mondays.
- **Baggage Policies:** Review your airline's baggage policies to avoid unexpected fees. Know the size and weight limits for checked and carry-on items.

Be Prepared for the Unexpected

- **Pack Essentials:** Bring snacks, medications, chargers, and any other important items in your carry-on luggage, in case of delays or cancellations.
