Russell Road detour now in effect near McCarran Airport

Traffic on Russell Road will be temporarily diverted from its regular east-west route to allow construction crews to install some underground water and utility lines. Work will take place east of McCarran International Airport between Maryland Parkway and Eastern Avenue.

There will be no lane restrictions, but drivers will have to maneuver through a temporary paved roadway located adjacent to Russell's usual lanes. Drivers are asked to use caution when traveling in the area. The detour is expected to remain in place for approximately 90 days.

The Clark County Department of Aviation is spending approximately \$55 million to realign Russell between Paradise and Eastern. Roadway changes are necessary to make way for Terminal 3, a \$1.8 billion addition that will greatly expand McCarran International Airport's ability to move travelers to and from Southern Nevada.
