Public Invited to Open House for Proposed Airport In Ivanpah

The Clark County Department of Aviation is hosting a public open house on Nov. 16, from 4 to 8 p.m. in the cafeteria of the Clark County Government Center, located at 500 S. Grand Central Parkway.

Clark County residents are invited to attend the open house to view informational graphics about the proposed airport project located in Ivanpah, and the Environmental Impact Statement process that must be completed before the airport can be built. Representatives from the Federal Aviation Administration, Bureau of Land Management and Vanasse, Hangen, Brustlin, Inc., the EIS contractor, will be present to answer questions.

“There is a significant amount of public interest in the proposed airport at Ivanpah,” said Randall H. Walker, director of the Clark County Department of Aviation. “Even though formal scoping meetings for the Environmental Impact Statement will be held in 2006, this open house will provide the public an opportunity to learn more about this exciting project now.”
