Motorists Urged to Use Alternate Route Due to Repair Work on Southbound Airport Connector Tunnel

Repair work to mitigate water runoff has begun and will continue on the southbound airport connector tunnel. This work includes sealing the tunnel roof by injecting an expansive foam product into overhead cracks. The northbound side of the project is complete.

Airport officials suggest using an alternate route while work is in progress. Traffic is reduced to one lane between 12:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m., Sundays through Thursdays until mid-November. To access Interstate-215, motorists may take Eastern Avenue and turn west on Sunset Road. The I-215 entrance is west of Paradise Road, off Sunset Road. Motorists using the southbound tunnel should expect delays due to lane closures and reduced speed limits to 35 mph during these periods.

Reparation to seal cracks in the airport connector tunnel began in June.
