Set out on a stress-free journey by purchasing tickets that best suit your destination!

Five types of transportation e-tickets catering to four popular tourist areas. Select a ticket that suits the destination or purpose of your trip.



Shima Onsen Area

With five hot spring districts, the Shima Onsen Area is ideal for strolling around the traditional resorts dotting the area.

• **Kan-etsu Transportation SHIMA ONSEN BUS TICKET**
Round-trip bus tickets between Nakanogo Station and Shima Onsen for 2,000 yen (adults)—save 100 yen! Also get on and off as many times as you want between these stops for up to two days.

* Child's fare is half price



Minakami Area

Rich in scenic nature and hot springs, the Minakami Area offers a broad range of outdoor activities.

• **Kan-etsu Transportation MINAKAMI AREA PASS**

Hop-on, hop-off between Gokan Station - Jomokogen Station - Sarugakyo Onsen, between Jomokogen Station - Minakami Station - Takaragawa Onsen - Yunokoya, and between Jomokogen Station - Tanigawadake Ropeway Station over two days, 3,500 yen for adults and 1,750 yen for children!



Kusatsu Onsen Area

The greatest hot spring output in Japan! Taking in the wonders of the natural scenery changing with the seasons is also another drawcard.

• **JR Bus Kanto Kusatsu Kogen Line Free Pass**
Round-trip bus tickets between Naganohara-Kusatsuguchi Station and Kusatsu Onsen Bus Terminal for 1,400 yen (adults)—save 20 yen! Also get on and off as many times as you want between these stops for up to two days.

* Child's fare is half price



Ikaho Onsen Area

One of the most famous hot spring areas in Japan known for its healing waters. Drop into the "power spots" in the area dressed in your yukata!

• **Ikaho Liner BUS TICKET**

One-way bus tickets from Takasaki Station to Ikaho Onsen, 2,000 yen for adults and 1,000 yen for children!

* This is not a hop-on, hop-off ticket

• **Kan-etsu Transportation SHIBUKAWA-IKAHO ONSEN BUS TICKET**
Hop-on, hop-off the bus between from Shibukawa Station and Ikaho Onsen over two days, 1,500 yen (adults)!

* Child's fare is half price

* For passengers only traveling return, purchasing normal tickets is cheaper

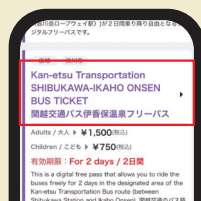

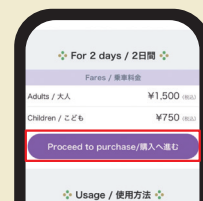
Choose and tap the Free Pass you want to purchase
