

[Rafting] Spring, when the river is swollen, is the best for rafting. Come and work together toward the goal, feeling the snow meltwater with your whole body!


World class Water Activity


【Taineiji Temple in Takumi no Sato】 About 2,000 hydrangeas are in full bloom in late July.






[Waterfall to bring romance] This waterfall, located in the midst of the forest along the Akaya River, is two-tiered and has a height of 20 meters.

Green to Red


Enjoy seasonal changes from fresh greenery to autumn foliage.


Every day throughout the year, you can enjoy freshly-baked apple pies made using plenty of apples grown in this orchard.





Culture and Crafts in Minakami

Culture, festivals and crafts passed down in the mountain village. Why not experience the tradition and craftsmanship here?



Horaku Matsuri (Festival) & Ookarasu Tengu Mikoshi

Horaku Matsuri is an autumn harvest festival held at Takumi no Sato. Ookarasu Tengu Mikoshi (Portable Shrine for Great Crow Tengu (Goblin)) is carried around the venue. This powerful performance is worth watching.



Shigetsukai at Gakurinji Temple in Mt. Omine

You can watch the beautiful moon which is suitable for the place name "Tsukiyono" (literally translated as "Moon Night Field"). Tsukiyono's moon watched at "Shigetsukai"(moon watching party) is designated as one of Japan 100 moons by the General Incorporated Association YAKEI Convention & Visitors Bureau.



Unique Festival "Ogawajima Yassa Matsuri"

This is a wild and exciting festival with a history of 400 years. Praying for the productiveness of grain, the state of perfect health, and the elimination of flood disaster, participants in the festival, shouting "Yassa, Mossa, Shinjuro", run around, walk around, crawl around the shrine precinct and cut the rope of the large bell at the end.



Takumi no Sato

Takumi no Sate is the place where you can try making various things such as wood crafts, bamboo crafts and washi (Japanese paper) crafts. Surrounded by clean air, clean water and a lot of smiling faces, you feel time goes by slowly here.



Minwa to Kamishibai no Ie (Folktale and Picture Story House)

Sarugakyo Onsen, Gunma Prefecture, once flourished as a post station on the Mikuni Kaido Road connecting Edo (current Tokyo) and Echigo (current Niigata). Merchants and travelling entertainers came and went, telling locals a lot of folktales. At the Minwa to Kamishibai no le, more than five hundred folktales passed down locally are narrated live, the history of Kamishibai (picture story) is explained by using a peep show, about two thousand Kamishibai stories including those before World War Two are exhibited and demonstrated, and hand-made Kamishibai stories are introduced.



Tsukiyono Yaki

Tsukiyono Yaki is a type of unique-colored pottery made by burning the bowls which are formed by the pottery wheel technique passed down for Hasami Yaki pottery and to which individually prepared glazes have been applied. The fiery red cinnabar glaze is the most remarkable of all.

MINAKAMI TOWN INFORMATION.

What Minakmai Town Is like

Situated in the northernmost of Gunma Prefecture in the northern part of the Kanto region, Minakami is a beautiful town rich in nature and hot springs, which is at the foot of Mt. Tanigawa and Mt. Mikuni, and home to the headwaters of the Tone River, and is often referred to as the "Water Reservoir for Kanto". Minakami is the largest town in the Kanto region and each area in Minakami has its own distinctive traits.



Minakami/Fujiwara area





This area lies along the valley at the head of the Tone River. You can enjoy mountains, water and rich nature actively. Throughout the year, you can have a good time in doing various activities.

Sarugakyo/Mikuni area





This area along the Mikuni Kaido road offers rural scenery and the historical atmosphere of the old road.

You can enjoy pottery making in a laid-back atmosphere.

Tsukiyono/Kamimoku area





Situated at the entrance to Minakami, this is an area where you can find how local people live their everyday life. People love Tsukiyo (Moon Night) as it is named, and cultural atmosphere and nature are in harmony.

MINAKAMI BIOSPHERE RESERVE.



Town - home to the headwaters of the Tone River, and "UNESCO Biosphere Reserve (also known here as UNESCO Eco Park)" nurturing water, forests and people

We must leave the natural environment and landscape, which are the greatest regional treasures, and a lot of "gifts" from forests, including water, to our children who will build the future of Minakami. We are aiming to maintain the status of the UNESCO Biosphere Reserve which nurtures "people" with abilities to nurture water and forests, and "protect, utilize and spread" them in order to build a sustainable town where people can live in harmony with nature while being grateful to the natural environment which has been protected with great care.



Overview

Minakami UNESCO Biosphere Reserve consists mainly of Minakami Town, which is situated in the northernmost of Gunma Prefecture, and partly of adjacent Uonuma City, Minami Uonuma City and Yuzawa Town of Niigata Prefecture.

It has a total area of 91,368 hectares (more than 90% of the area is occupied by forests) and is about 300 to 2000 meters high.

This area is situated in the upper-most part of the Tone River, which is Japan's representative great river with a length of 322 km (the second longest in Japan), and a drainage area of 16,840m² (the largest in Japan). From this area originates the first drop of the water which supports the lives and livelihood of 30 million people, about 80% of those who live in the metropolitan area (around Tokyo, capital of Japan) which is one of the largest economic and most populous areas in the world.





Characteristics

The mountain ridge bordering Gunma Prefecture and Niigata Prefecture is the mountainous backbone where the atmosphere on the Pacific Ocean side clashes with that on the Sea of Japan side, that is, the central divide. This area is one of the world's heaviest snowfall areas. Mainly due to the effects of heavy snowfall in winter, the mountainous region has a variety of distinctive land features such as nivation hollows, floodplains, river terraces, in addition to steep rocky cliffs and bare rock surfaces, and land features peculiar to heavy snowfall belts, such as periglacial landform. Traces of glaciers have also been found despite the region being less than 2,000 meters high. These unique landscape and geological factors, together with the fact that this region is in the transitional zone of climate conditions between the Sea of Japan side and the Pacific Ocean side, have nurtured various rare animals and plants,











MINAKAMI AREA MAP.
