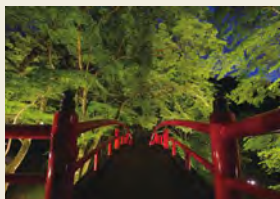

The second source of Kogane-no-yu (meaning "golden spring") can be found here.



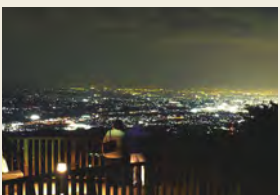

A reconstruction of a Sekisho (inspection point) established by the Edo Shogunate in 1631.

Ikaho's Hot Springs

You can enjoy two types of hot springs at Ikaho Onsen. One is known as the "Kogane-no-yu", golden colored for its abundance in iron. The other is known as "Shirogane-no-yu", spring water glistening with transparency.

Kogane-no-yu

Spring type: Sulfate spring
Good for: Scars, peripheral circulatory failure, poor circulation, etc.

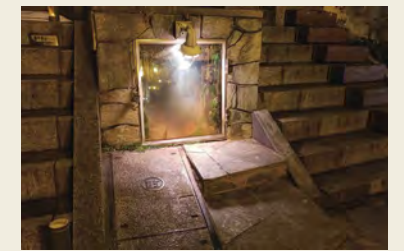
Shirogane-no-yu

Spring type: Acknowledged as an "onsen" as stipulated in the metasilicic acid clause of Article 2 of the Hot Spring Law
Good for: Recovery from illness / fatigue, health improvement

Ishidangai (stone steps)

Near 94-2 Ikaho, Ikaho-machi

"Ishidangai" was developed about 440 years ago based on Japan's first hot spring city plan. Enjoy the tranquil ambience of this city of stone steps.



Komaguchi

The onsen baths of each inn are drawn from tapping spouts connected to the hot spring source. You can see the spring being drawn at Komaguchi.

Gunma Prefectural Sports Park Ikaho Skating Rink



587-1 Ikaho, Ikaho-machi

This is an ice skating facility with a 400m international standard outside rink and 2 indoor rinks. Good for beginners as well as competing athletes.

Ikaho Ropeway

560-1 Ikaho, Ikaho-machi

Take a mid-air stroll on this ropeway connecting Ikaho Onsen and the summit of Monokiki-yama. Miharashi Sta. located on the summit is close to Ikaho Skating Rink and serves as a great access point for nature walks in the Ikaho Forest Park.

Tanashita Fudo Fall

Vigorous flow of water dropping from a 37m cliff naturally created by erosion of lava rocks of Mt. Akagi. The cliff creates a cave at the bottom where you can see the backside of the fall.



Funao Fall

Gushing from a height of about 72m, this majestic fall drops from its spout like a silky white ribbon slipping away.



Kamimiharada Kabuki Stage

Permanent Kabuki stage built in 1819. You can learn how the stage is operated or watch Kabuki performances.



Mizusawa Kannon Temple

Old Tendai sect temple. In the vast precincts, find the main temple, Rokkaku-do, Shaka-do, and its temple gates.



Shinko-ji Temple

Sorin-ji Temple

A famous temple serving as a Soto school, built by the owner of the Shiroi castle in mid-15th century.

This shrine is said to have been erected in 1184, worshipping Susanoo-no-mikoto, the deity for fortune of war and extermination of plagues.



Bukkozan Housui-ji Temple

Japan's head temple of a Taiwanese Rinza Buddhist sect Fo Guang Shan.
