This is an old ryokan inn that still stands at Isobe Onsen. The new building is five stories, while the old is two. Boasting a history of 140 years, the inn features the much praised Bijin no Yu (waters of beauty) from Isobe Onsen as well as kaiseki-style cuisine served on Japanese trays with the dishes mainly made from Gunma ingredients specially selected by the head chef. The spacious, genuine Japanese-style rooms are so close to the Usui River that you could fish for sweetfish from them. The entire staff will welcome you with warm hearts, as they put customer service first.
