



Welcome to Minakami

Situated in the northernmost part of the Kanto region, Minakami lies to the south of the foothills of the Tanigawa Mountain Range taken from Mount Tanigawa. Minakami is the largest town in the Kanto region, and has been designated as a UNESCO biosphere reserve. It is home to the headwaters of the Tone River, the most important source of water in the Kanto region, and is also known as the "Water Reservoir for Kanto".

Minakami is split into three areas.

Minakami/Fujiwara area

水上・藤原エリア
This area lies along the valley at the head of the Tone River, offering various activities year-round in the mountains, rivers, and lakes.

Sarugakyo/Mikuni area

猿ヶ京・三国エリア
This area along the Mikuni Kaido road offers rural scenery and the historical atmosphere of the old road. Here you can enjoy pottery making in a laid-back atmosphere.

Tsukiyono/Kamimoku area

月夜野・上牧エリア
Situating at the entrance to Minakami, this area lives and breathes with the daily lives of its residents. Just as its name implies (Tsukiyono means "moonlit field"), the culture of the area is in harmony with nature, and filled with love for moonlit nights.

There are various types to choose from, such as open-air baths along a valley with beautiful views year-round, hot spring inns at traditional Japanese houses over 100 years old, and hot springs facilities nestled deep in the mountains. The mountains and rivers of Okutone can be viewed from each and every hot spring.

La Biere
蒸焼きビザの店 ラ・ビエール
Made from dough kneaded with Minakami's pure water, the pizza with local ingredients served at this restaurant is very popular. Terrace seats are also available.

Ikufudo Seinikuten
育風堂精肉店
Come here for the ultimate quality in steaks, and thick cutlet rice bowls only a butcher's shop can provide.

Sobadokoro Kadoya
そば処 角野
Established 250 years ago, this restaurant serves handmade soba and udon noodles. Hegi Soba, their specialty, is wonderfully chewy, full of flavor and served with excellent dipping sauce. Tempura made with seasonal ingredients is also recommended.

Wafu Restaurant Shinrin
和風レストラン しんりん
This Japanese restaurant serves Joshu Barley Pork meat dishes as well as meals made with plenty of vegetables and rice produced in Minakami. Their popular Waraji Sauce Cutlet Rice Bowl features cutlets fried to perfection with homemade sauce.

Amenimo Makezu

This shabu-shabu specialty restaurant serves Gunma brand pork such as Gunma Barley Pork served with soba soup. There are also an assortment of reasonably-priced lunch options and an a la carte menu.

Garba Cafe
バームクーヘン菓子工房 ガルバカフェ
This baumkuchen specialty shop bakes their cakes using domestic flour and fresh local eggs. BUNA is a popular menu item. The cafe serves sets of coffee and cake.

Amaimonoya Umenomitsu

甘いものや 梅の蜜
This restaurant is located inside Yunoyado Joetsukan. All of the food is handmade, and the healthy buffet lunch is popular. They also have a wide assortment of sweets.

Nobotokesoba Yamaichiya
野仏そば やまいち屋
Every day, buckwheat grains are ground in a stone mill, then kneaded by hand and served fresh. There are also plenty of dishes with their secret miso sauce, such as Miso Katsu Meal.

Otowaya Cafe
オトワヤ カフェ
This cafe adjoins Takuminosato Horakukan. Their dishes made with local ingredients and sweets made using ripe Minakami fruits are popular.

Kimamaya

気まま屋
Come taste handmade bread baked with local ingredients in Minakami Onsen Town. Minakami Apple Pie, available only from September to April, is made of flaky pie crust filled with mildly sweet stewed apples.

Umaimonoya Suehiro
うまいもの屋 すえひろ
This Japanese restaurant was established in 1965. Their famous Stacked Tonkatsu, made with Joshu Barley Pork, is a soft, juicy cutlet consisting of very thinly sliced meat.

Humpty Dumpty

This restaurant opened in 2013. Enjoy authentic Indian curry while listening to good music, and try their healthy, tasty, creative dishes made with local vegetables.

6 June	E8 Minakami Outdoor Festival みなかみアウトドアフェスティバル Come and see demonstrations by top competitors and participate in a variety of activities yourself. This two-day outdoor festival offers the best of Minakami's nature. Two days between late May and early June MAP A-1 mofest.jp/en/
