Featured in every room throughout the entire establishment are traditional household items and furnishings that number in the thousands, making them the largest collection of such items in Japan. Take the free shuttle bus (lodgers only) from there. Take the Kan-Etsu Kotsu Bus from Gunma-Haramachi Station on JR Agatsuma Line headed for Asama-Kakushi Onsen Area for about 30 minutes. Get off at Asama-Kakushi Onsen (last stop). (Buses are infrequent, however, so we recommend you travel by car.)</p>
