The Tomioka Silk Mill is a model mechanized silk-reeling factory built in 1872 by the Meiji government to modernize Japan. This government managed silk mill was built in order to spread automated silk production techniques throughout the country that could produce large quantities of high quality silk. Its worth was recognized internationally when it was registered on the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites in 2014 as Tomioka Silk Mill and Related Sites.
