

## Sharpie Easter Eggs

Decorating Easter eggs are a tradition for many but the process of dying and dripping can get messy. This Easter, leave the mess in the past and express your creativity using Sharpie markers instead!

What you need:

- Room temperature hard boiled eggs
- Sharpie Fine Permanent Markers, Assorted
- or Metallic
- Rubbing alcohol
- Eye dropper

STEP 1 – Colour the eggs with your Sharpie markers.

STEP 2 – If you desire a blended effect in your design, use rubbing alcohol to subtly swirl your Sharpie colours together.

With your eye dropper, slowly add drops of alcohol to the areas you want blended. The more drops you add, the greater the blurring effect will be. Allow to dry when done.

Tips:

- Use room temperature eggs
- Cover your egg completely with Sharpie marker for best results
- Drip the rubbing alcohol very slowly
