

Feature Slime Recipe



Frosty Winter Slime

Supplies Needed:

- 177 ml (6 oz) Elmer's Blue Glitter Glue
- 177 ml (6 oz) Elmer's Silver Glitter Glue
- 177 ml (6 oz) Elmer's White School Glue
- 1/2 tbsp of baking soda
- 1¼ tbsp of contact lens solution

Instructions:

1. Pour out 177 ml (6 oz) of Elmer's Glitter Glue into a bowl.
2. Add ½ tbsp of baking soda and mix thoroughly.
3. Add 1¼ tbsp of contact lens solution.
4. Mix until mixture gets harder to mix and slime begins to form.
5. Take the slime out and begin kneading with both of your hands.
6. If needed, add ¼ tbsp of contact lens solution to make the slime less sticky.

Repeat steps 1 – 6 to make the next two Slime batches, Silver Glitter and White Glue. Once all colours are created, lay them on top of each other and then swirl and twist! If you knead too much, the colours will eventually mix and become one. Have fun playing with your snow indoors, snow slime that is!

*Adult supervision is required; This project is not appropriate for children under the age of 3 years. Always wash your hands before and after making and playing with slime. Warning: If large quantities of contact lens solution are accidentally ingested (greater than a tablespoon), get medical attention immediately.
