


Understanding Directions

This picture shows a globe. A globe is a model of Earth. A globe is the same shape as Earth but much smaller.

Read the labels on the globe. The North and South poles help you tell directions. North is toward the North Pole. South is toward the South Pole. When you face north, east is to your right. West is to your left.

North North Pole East South Pole South

A compass rose is a symbol that shows the four main directions on a map. On a compass rose the letters N, S, E, and W stand for the four directions.


