


A Vegetation Map

The different kinds of trees and plants that grow in an area are called vegetation. This map shows vegetation on the continent of Africa.



The vegetation in the West African countries of Ghana, Ivory Coast, and Nigeria includes the cacao tree. The seeds from these trees produce most of the world's chocolate.
