### IN-EAR

- Compact, portable, stay in place
- Rubber/silicone tips block noise

- Lightweight, non-invasive
- Limited external noise penetration

- Elevated sound quality
- Foam pads block noise

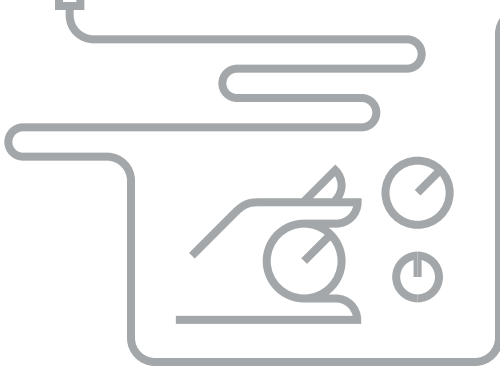
#### GOOD FOR:

### WIRED

- Higher performance
- No charging necessary

## NOISE CANCELLATION

### ACTIVE NOISE CANCELLATION (ANC)

- Measures, counteracts noise
- Option to disable ANC waves

### PASSIVE NOISE ISOLATION (PNI)

- Physical attributes reduce noise
- No ANC pressure on ears

- 3D encapsulating sound
