Sharpie Shrink Keychain Charms

As a natural do-it-yourselfer with creativity that knows no bounds transform your plastic containers into adorable keychains in a few easy steps!

What you need:

- Clean transparent plastic packaging (#6)
- Scissors
- Hole puncher
- Key chain rings
- Jump rings
- Sharpie Fine Permanent Markers, Assorted
- STEP 1 Cut out a large, flat piece of plastic
- STEP 2 Get inspired! Do some research to find samples of images you'd like to use.
- STEP 3 Begin drawing your image! Keep in mind that the images will shrink by up to 70% in the oven, so make sure they are large enough.
- STEP 4 Punch a hole at the top of your plastic. This hole will be used to attach the charm to a bracelet or to make a necklace.
- STEP 5 Cut out the image making sure not to cut off the hole.
- STEP 6 Place the plastic on a baking sheet and bake it for two minutes at 165 °C (330 °F).
- STEP 7 Take the charms out of the oven.
- STEP 8 Once room temperature, attach jump rings to the charms and connect them to your key chain rings!

Tip:

• It's best to use a black Sharpie and start with the outline.
