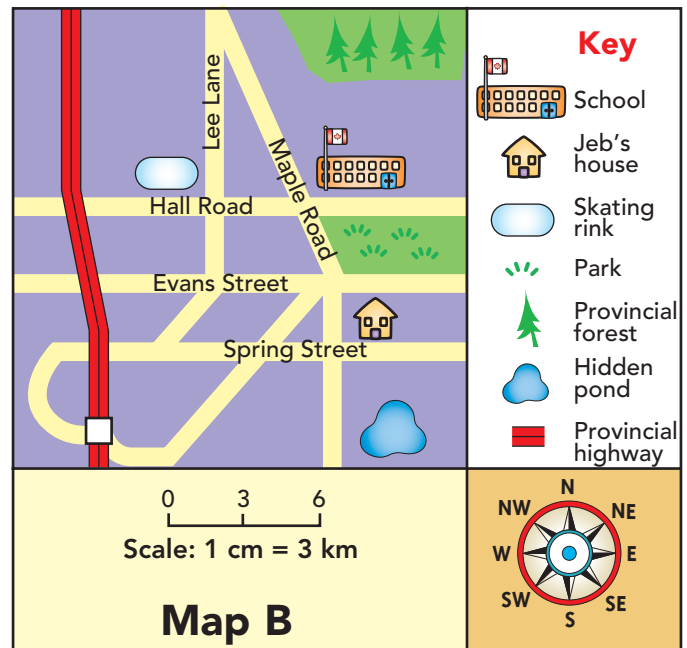
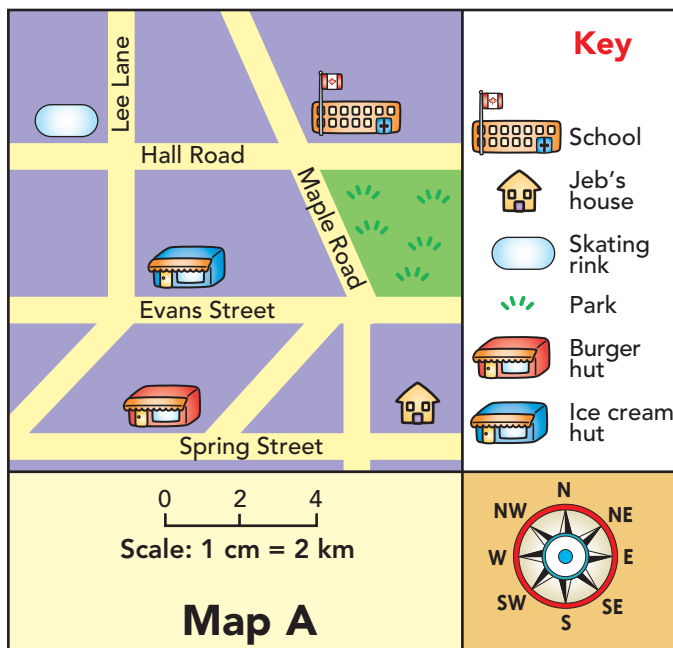




Comparing Maps and Scales
