
Sergeant does his rounds four times a day. Using the Advent Calendar as a map, can you draw what you think he might see during his day?


Ben loves bells. What do you think his collection of bells looks like? Are they all shapes and sizes?


Georgia Bean loves to bake for the mice. What do you think one of her birthday cakes looks like? And pies? What are the ingredients?


The Rowland kits love to collect lace and jewels and sweets. What are some things you like to collect?




We all love the mice — and there are so many of them! What would you look like as a mouse? What would your family look like? Your friends?






Sally loves to exercise — especially on her obstacle course in the Treasures. Can you draw what you think her obstacle course might look like?




Melody sings a song especially for the Junkyard animals that helps them feel their feelings together. What are some of your favorite Christmas songs? Can you draw a picture of one of them?


The holiday season is filled with heroes and superheroes. Who are some of the people in your life that are like superheroes? Can you draw a picture of them next to these brave and busy beavers?


