## **Dirt Dessert**

*(Makes about 6 servings)*

### **Ingredients**

- 1 box chocolate pudding mix
- 2 cups cold milk
- 4 ounces whipping cream
- 2 Tablespoons sugar
- ½ teaspoon vanilla
- 1 (14.3 ounce package) of chocolate sandwich cookies
- several gummy worms

### **Directions**

Make the pudding according to the package directions and put it in the fridge to set.

Meanwhile, add the whipping cream, sugar, and vanilla to the bowl of a stand mixer and whisk on high for several minutes to make whipped cream.

While the cream is whipping, pour the cookies into a large plastic bag. Seal the bag well and use a rolling pin or large can to gently crush the cookies into “dirt”.

Once the cream is whipped and the pudding is set, gently fold the whipped cream into the pudding. Then fold in half of the cookie crumbs.

Spoon the pudding mixture into jars, cups, or food safe flower pots, leaving about an inch of space at the top. Top the pudding with the remaining cookie crumbs to make a nice layer of topsoil. Garnish each pot with 3 or 4 gummy worms.
