Tuna Fish Kitty Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 can (about 5 ounces) tuna
- 1 egg
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1/3 cup shredded cheese
- 1 tablespoon fresh, chopped parsley
- 1 1/3 cups flour

Directions

Preheat your oven to 350 degrees and grease two baking sheets.

Then, in the bowl of a food processor, mix together the tuna, egg, and olive oil, until the tuna has broken down into a paste. Add the cheese and egg, and pulse a few times to combine. Last add the flour, and mix until the dough comes together in a ball.

Roll the dough out onto a lightly floured cutting board, until it's about 1/2 inch thick. From there, you can use cookie cutters to make the treats into shapes, or you can just cut little squares. Either way, you want the treats to be about a square inch—not too big for your kitty to crunch on.

Lay the treats out onto your greased baking sheets, and bake for 15-18 minutes. Allow to cool completely, then store in the fridge in an airtight container. Because these don't have the preservatives that ordinary cat treats have, discard any treats that haven't been eaten after a few weeks.
