Moreover, the Midland system also solves the serious problem of blind spots, a nightmare for every driver in general, but especially for truck drivers. This model proposed by Midland is even more stable and economical than previous versions, increasingly meeting the needs of those driving heavy-duty vehicles.

Truck drivers face many more difficulties compared to car drivers, and many complications and accidents could be avoided thanks to tools that help prevent driver fatigue, always dealing with the problem of moving and controlling the heavy vehicle.
