We've had a strong and exciting start to 2024. From increased passenger volumes to added flights and new campus developments, we have a lot to look forward to throughout the year.

We are happy to report that passenger volume in 2023 increased 15% over 2022, and our global cargo ranking moved up five spots from number 17 to number 12. These measures are significant to track performance for both sides of the operation. We expect passenger volumes to continue to climb with demand still strong, and several new flights with Frontier and Breeze will start in the coming months. Several other announcements were made this quarter. Seven new concessions will be coming to our concourses, and construction projects across campus are taking place as we continue to elevate the role of our airport.

In addition to this activity, we were thrilled to recently be named a top airport in North America serving five to 15 million passengers through the renowned Airport Service Quality (ASQ) Awards. CVG was also one of only eight airports in the world to be inducted into the ACI World Director General's Roll of Excellence, a recognition given to airports that have won multiple ASQ awards over a five-year period. We are incredibly proud of these recognitions as they are based on direct, positive passenger feedback.
