## DBE FY2022 - 2024 GOAL Oxford Airport (OXD)

As required by the provisions of 49 CFR Part 26, Miami University, sponsor of the Oxford Airport (OXD) located in Oxford, Ohio, has established an overall goal for the participation of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) in projects for which Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funds may be utilized during Federal Fiscal Years 2022-2024 (October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2024).

OXD's **overall goal is 2.32%** of which 0.0% is expected through race/gender neutral methods and 2.32% is expected through race/gender conscious methods. OXD anticipates applying AIP and Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) funds to the following projects planned for FY2022-2024: Runway pavement sealing, airfield marking improvements and runway obstruction removal, REIL replacement, hangar / terminal rehabilitation and wildlife fencing.
