



#### **Monthly Cargo Tonnage Trend**






June cargo volume 132,121 tons, YTD +15 percent\*

#### U.S. System – TSA Security Passenger Throughput Trend





#### **CVG – TSA Security Passenger Throughput Trend**






CVG Year-Over-Year Passenger TSA Throughput Continues to Improve – July ~83% of 2019 Levels

#### **American Airlines Developments**

- Currently CVG's 2<sup>nd</sup> largest carrier
- Current Destinations: CLT, DCA, DFW, MIA, ORD, PHL
- New York (LGA) Returns August 4<sup>th</sup>
- Seasonal Phoenix now planned for year around service starting August 17th (Daily)
- New Austin service planned for September 8th
  - 2x daily effective October 1st
- New York (JFK) Returns October 7<sup>th</sup>
- New Boston service planned for November 2021
  - 3x daily service
- Overall 4Q 2021 growth at CVG will be approximately 38% compared to pre-pandemic 4Q 2019
