Via Application 18, the Board is requesting the FAA's approval to collect and use PFCs in the amount and for the project hereinafter described.

1. Snow Removal Equipment

Estimated PFC Funded Project Costs: \$19,891,500

Description:

This project includes the purchase of twenty-two new pieces of snow removal equipment. Including six multi-function units, two sanders, four blowers, seven loaders and three deicers. The new equipment will replace older snow removal equipment, which has reached its useful life and will be taken out of service. The equipment will be used on-Airport to clear snow from the airport operations area in accordance with the Airport's snow and ice control plan.

Justification:

The replacement of the prior snow removal and deicing equipment is necessary given that the pieces of equipment had reached the end of their useful lives and were becoming prohibitively difficult to maintain. Much of the equipment being replaced was purchased prior to 2005.

The costs associated with the snow removal equipment project are eligible for AIP funding, and therefore PFC funding, per Table M-1(d) of FAA Order 5100.38D, Change 1.
