










Airfield Projects: 2024-2028



PLAN

- Review and prioritize 5-year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)
- Develop financing plan for the CIP inclusive of the Elevate CVG Program
- Guided by primary financial objectives
 - Minimum liquidity at 400 days
 - Minimum 1.75x Debt Service Coverage
 - Reasonable cost per enplanement (CPE)
- Issue debt to fund portions of the 5-year CIP
 - Bond (GARB) capacity estimated at \$500M
 - Anticipate multiple bond issues 1st in Q3 2024



NEXT

- Bonds
 - Bond Underwriter Proposals due April 4
 - Recommendation to May 13th Board
 - Bond Resolution and related documents July 15th Board
- Program Management/Construction Management (PM/CM) Solicitation – extension of staff
 - Release May/June
 - Recommendation to November 18th Board
- Design-Builder (DB) Solicitation
 - Release late-June/July
 - Recommendation to November 18th Board
