

- Nonstop Cities In January airlines offered nonstop scheduled service to 42 domestic destinations and 3 international destinations.



• Total cargo in the month of January 2023 was 150,699 tons compared to January 2022 tonnage of 150,312 an increase of 0.3 percent year over year.



Landed Weight

Comments:

- Landed weight from passenger operations in the month of January 2023 increased 6.5 percent to 350.5 million pounds compared to 329.1 million pounds in January 2022.
- Landed weight from cargo operations in the month of January 2023 increased 8.7 percent to 790.8 million pounds compared to 727.6 million pounds in January 2022.
- Total landed weight in January increased 8.0 percent compared to January 2022.
