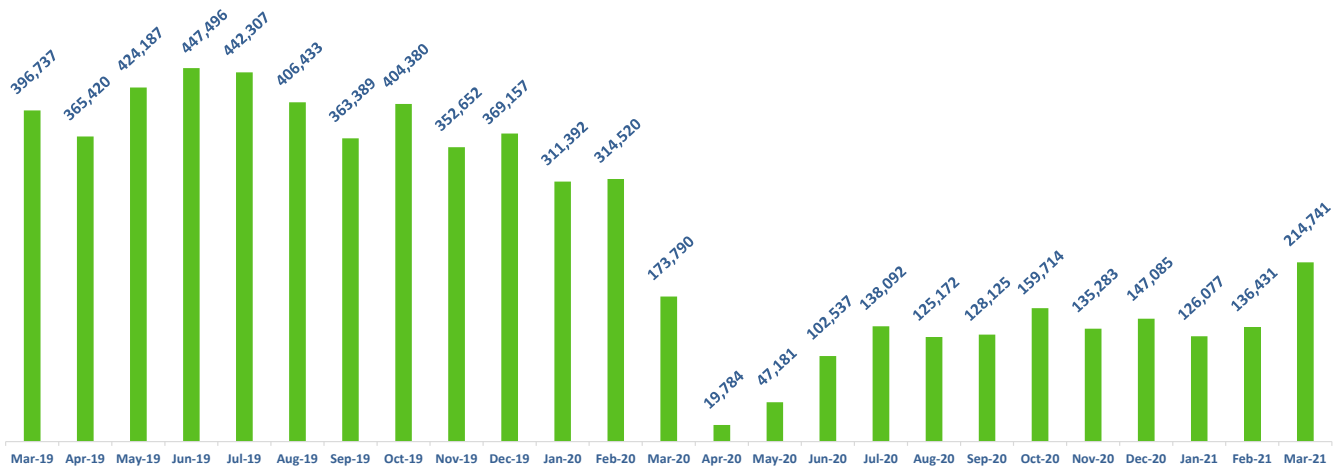

- Total enplanements for March 2021 were 214,741, a decrease of 45.9 percent compared to enplanements in March 2019 of 396,737. \*Note: Comparison year adjusted to 2019 due to Covid pandemic.

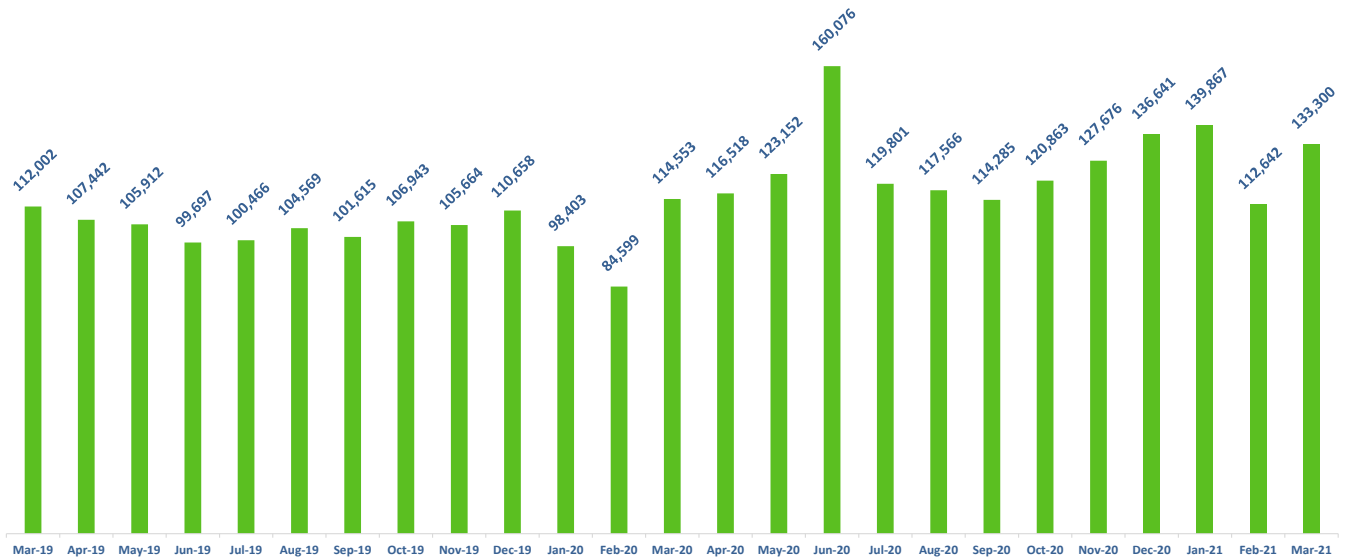

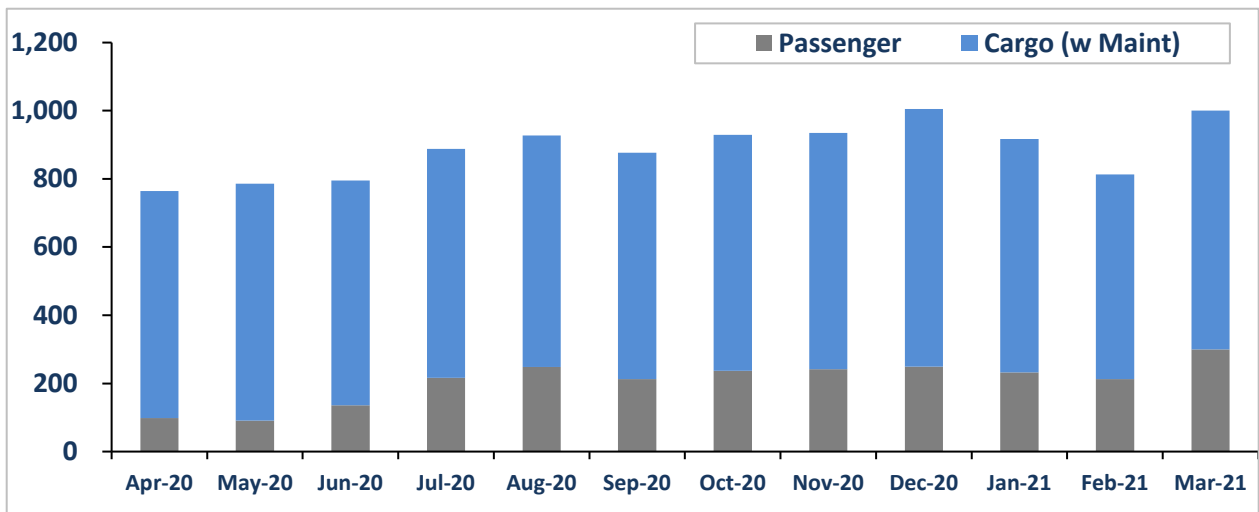
## Cargo Volume



### Comments:

- Total cargo in the month of March 2021 was 133,300 tons compared to March 2019 tonnage of 112,002 an increase of 19 percent. \*Note: Comparison year adjusted to 2019 due to Covid pandemic.

## Landed Weight



### Comments:

- Landed weight from passenger operations in the month of March 2021 decreased 31.5 percent to 299.8 million pounds compared to 437.4 million pounds in March 2019. \*Note: Comparison year adjusted to 2019 due to Covid pandemic.
- Landed weight from cargo operations in the month of March 2021 increased 14.6 percent to 700.2 million pounds compared to 611.2 million pounds in March 2019. \*Note: Comparison year adjusted to 2019 due to Covid pandemic.
