Monthly Volume: November 2020 – October 2022




October cargo volume 190,562 tons, +22.2 percent Year-Over-Year; YTD +18.2 percent*

October 2022 overall landed weight increased 13.7 percent; YTD up 7.8 percent compared to 2019



U.S. System – TSA Security Passenger Throughput Trend






October 2022 National TSA Throughput was 95%, November trends continue to be positive

CVG – TSA Security Passenger Throughput Trend









CVG Seat Capacity Recovery Trend 2022-2023 compared to 2019
