TICKETING

- There will be a full ticket collection for this fixture, with members of the Rangers Ticketing Team in attendance to facilitate it.
- The ticket collection point is located at a kiosk at the away section of the stadium and will be open between 15:00 and 20:30 (local time).
 - Address – Liebenauer Hauptstraße 18, 8041 Graz
 - Coordinates – 47.045811, 15.456326

- We encourage supporters to collect their ticket as early as possible to allow for a smoother entry process when turnstiles open.
- A valid form of photographic ID will be required to collect your ticket – a photocopy or picture of ID will not be accepted.
- Please note that you will only be able to collect your own ticket, and no other supporter can pick it up on your behalf.



RECOMMENDED SUPPORTER AREA

- Supporters are recommended to gather around Hauptplatz within the city centre, which has plenty of bars and restaurants.
- This area provides convenient access to the tram network and is an approximate 45-minute walk to the stadium.



HOW TO GET TO THE STADIUM

- **Public Transport:** Board the Number 4 Tram from Hauptplatz and alight at Jauerburggasse. The journey takes approximately 11-minutes. Please note, trams will also be utilised by home supporters.
- **Walking:** The away section is an approximate 12-minute walk from Jauerburggasse or a 45-minute walk from Hauptplatz.
- **Taxi:** Supporters can order taxis via [878](#) or Uber. The maximum cost from the city centre to the stadium should be 17 euros.

- The stadium will open 2 hours before kick-off.
- Our supporters will be positioned in sections 26 and 27. Both share the same entry points, and supporters can move freely on the concourse.

ENTRY DETAILS

- Flags and banners are permitted, however should not contain offensive or political messaging.
- We have been advised that battery packs will be permitted, but they should not exceed the size of your phone.
- Bags smaller than A5 are allowed, however backpacks and large handbags will not be permitted for entry.
- There are limited storage facilities available at the stadium.
- Cash and card payments are accepted within the stadium.
- Various refreshments will be available within the stadium, including beer, wine, soft drinks and food items.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Passport Requirements

- Austria follows Schengen area entry rules. Your passport must have been issued less than 10 years before your arrival date and must be valid for at least 3 months after the day you plan to leave the Schengen area. If your passport was renewed before 1 October 2018, check carefully, as it may have a date of issue that is more than 10 years ago.

Laws and Cultural Differences

- **Personal ID** – By law, you must always have easy access to your passport. If you do not carry your passport, you must be able to get it quickly. It can be helpful to carry a copy of the photo page. The Austrian authorities do not accept a UK driving licence as official ID.
- **Face Coverings** – It's generally illegal to wear any clothing or object in public that covers your face. You could get a fine of up to 150 euros.
- **Illegal Drugs** – Illegal drugs, including cannabis, carry severe penalties.

You should expect a long jail sentence and heavy fines for possessing, using or smuggling illegal drugs, including when transiting through the airport.



SUPPORTER MESSAGE

Across the continent, the Rangers support are renowned for their incredible backing both in noise and in colour.

Supporters are, however, reminded the club remains under a suspended stand closure sanction. That means should there be any repeat of what UEFA deems as 'racist and/or discriminatory behaviour', it could lead to further sanctions and a full stand closure.

In addition, the club is under a suspended away section ban which will be triggered if pyrotechnics are used at future fixtures. Should this occur, it would result in Rangers supporters being locked out of a key away match, directly impacting those who travel in such numbers to follow the team.

Both sanctions mean thousands of fellow Rangers supporters could be deprived of the opportunity to attend important games, while the players on the pitch would lose a significant proportion of the amazing support you provide.

Discriminatory behaviour includes (but is not limited to) illicit singing, chanting, or the displaying of banners.

Ahead of this match, and indeed the remainder of the season, the club also reminds supporters the throwing of objects onto the pitch is unacceptable, illegal, and will lead to serious consequences for the club and the potential arrest of the individuals responsible.

We call on all our travelling support to back the team in the right manner and prove once again what a force for good the Rangers support can be.
