

Lake Erie College Undergraduate Admissions Revocation Policy

All applicants and admitted students are expected to uphold the highest standards of honesty, integrity, and personal conduct throughout the admissions process and their transition to Lake Erie College (LEC). Otherwise, LEC staff reserve the right to revoke an offer of admission at any time, for any reason, at their discretion. Grounds for revocation may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Failing to maintain academic performance as presented in the admissions application;
- Falsifying, misleading, or providing incomplete information during the application process;
- Failing to provide final, official transcripts and/or additional required documentation by established deadlines;
- Violating the College's code of ethics or community standards;
- Displaying behavior that reflects negatively on the student's character or integrity, whether occurring before or after the offer of admission; or
- other reasons deemed appropriate by the Vice President of Enrollment, in consultation with other college leadership, in alignment with its mission, values, and institutional policies.

Decisions to revoke admission prior to enrollment will be made by the Vice President of Admissions in consultation with appropriate institutional leadership. If it is determined that a student no longer meets the conditions or expectations of admission after the student has matriculated, the Vice President of Enrollment, may rescind admission in consultation with the Academics Standard committee.
