

Donation Horse Trial Contract

Here follows an agreement between the Lake Erie College and

is being loaned to the Lake Erie College Equestrian Center beginning on _____ (date) for a 21 day trial to ascertain if Lake Erie College will accept this horse into the teaching program.

Lake Erie College will not be responsible for any injury to the above described horse while at the Lake Erie College Equestrian Center, while being transported to or from the Equestrian Center, or while being used in the riding program. It is understood that the owner of this horse has indicated all vices and special needs and declares this horse to be SOUND, in good health and of good disposition. The Owner also declares that they own the horse free and clear.

After a 21-day trial in our horse program, the above horse will either be eligible for acceptance as a donation or it will be declined for donation. Signification of acceptance for donation will be by initial telephone or email contact from Lake Erie College to the owner, followed by acceptance and signing by Lake Erie College of the completed TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP CONTRACT.

UPON NOTIFICATION by Lake Erie College that the horse is being declined for donation, the horse must be removed within seven (7) days at the owner's expense. Beginning seven (7) days after telephone, electronic or email notification, a board fee of \$25 per day will be assessed to the owner. All transportation costs related to this horse for the trial period will be the responsibility of the horse owner.

Requirements before arrival at Lake Erie College Equestrian Center:

- Vaccination for Western, Eastern Encephalitis and West Nile Virus within 6 months if horse is arriving between April 1 and November 1.
- Vaccination for Influenza and Rhinopneumonitis -within 6 months of arrival date
- Vaccination for Rabies and Tetanus within 1 year of arrival date
- Vaccination for Strangles within one year of arrival date (recommended but not mandatory)
- Proof of Negative Coggins test within <u>ELEVEN (11) months</u> of arrival date. (This ensures negative Coggins throughout the 21-day trial.)
- Horse should be shod/reset within 4 weeks of arrival. Lake Erie College will not provide farrier service during the trial period except in an emergency. Any farrier service required during the trial period will be done at Owner's expense.
- Horse should be dewormed with ivermectin or show proof of negative or low-shedder fecal within 60 days of arrival.
- <u>The Equestrian Center office must receive written documentation of above information and Coggins before</u> your horse arrives at our facility. If the horse arrives at the Equestrian Center without this documentation the horse will not be allowed to unload at our facility. For your horse's health, our veterinarians strongly recommend your horse receive any required vaccinations at least three (3) weeks prior to traveling to Lake Erie College.
- Owners must provide all medications and feed supplements required during the time of the donation trial.
- Owners must provide complete medical records for the horse for the past three years, submitted to the college for consideration of this donation.

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- This signed release provides Lake Erie College access to the medical records of the horse. Please provide the name and contact information of the veterinarian supplying medical information. A copy of the signed release must be in the hands of the donor's vet for the vet to release any information to Lake Erie College.
- Once on the premises, only Lake Erie College faculty/staff/students may ride the horse. Owners may visit during open barn hours only (8:30 AM – 4:00 PM M-F)
- Lake Erie College will conduct basic soundness exam within one week of arrival and will correspond with the Owner during the trial period if there are any immediate concerns about the horse's soundness, health or general suitability for use in our teaching program.
