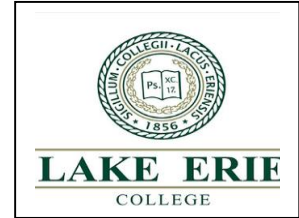


AGREEMENT FOR LOAN OF ARTWORK

The Artist has been invited to submit/donate artwork for possible sale at the Lake Erie College **Arts Gala Event**, taking place in the B.K. Smith Gallery of the Royce Hall for the Fine and Performing Arts, on July 30, 2022.

Item 1: Artist has been invited to participate in the Fine Arts Gala on July 30, 2022 at no charge or fee for submission or hanging.

Item 2: Artist's artwork shall be for sale or auction, with the minimum price decided by the Artist. The percentage split of sale proceeds shall be 60% Artist / 40% LEC Arts Gala. The buyer's payment shall be made to Lake Erie College, with Artist receiving their share from the College on or before August 8.

Item 3: **There is no guarantee of sale** for any art submitted to the event.

Item 5: Artist will provide two full color JPEG photos of art on or before June 20, along with completed agreement form.

Item 6: Artwork may be removed from display by the buyer when the Gala ends on July 30. Pickup hours for sold and unsold items will be 10AM-1PM Sunday, July 31.

Item 7: **Artist will deliver artwork to BK Smith Gallery of the Royce Hall for the Fine and Performing Arts on July 23rd between 10am & 4pm.** Storage will be in a secure area. Volunteers of the Arts Gala committee will hang and display all artwork.

Item 8: Artist will be expected to **pick up unsold artwork on Sunday, July 31** between 10am-1pm at Lake Erie College's B.K. Smith Gallery of the Royce Hall for the Fine and Performing Arts located on Gillett St. (*alternate arrangements may be available).

Item 9: During its custody of the artwork, from delivery to pick up, the College shall be responsible, to the best of its ability, to secure the safety and undamaged condition of artwork. The Artist expressly agrees to assume eventual risks of loss or damage to the art works arising out of the display of the art works at the Arts Gala. The Artist releases the College and its directors, administrators, employees, and independent contractors from liability. The Artist waives any claims against the College now or in the future arising out of the display of the artwork(s), including, without limitation, claims of damage, injury, theft, vandalism, fire, casualty, acts of God, or other unexplained causes, to the full extent permitted by law.
