Our Career Support is embedded in the academic experience through our **Pathway to Empowerment Program (P2E)**. Through our innovative and signature P2E personal and professional development programming, these courses give support and focus for every academic year. It helps you gain the skills you need and offers support as alumni to continue to help you in your career.

FIRST DESTINATION PROCEDURE & RESULTS

2020 was a challenging year for destination data as there were no group graduation ceremonies in 2020 and it was during graduation practice that our grad survey was historically a requirement for all participants.
