### Pell Recalculation Policy

Pell Recalculation refers to the process in which Pell Grant students with enrollment changes during the semester may have their Pell Grant adjusted to reflect current enrollment. The federal government requires all colleges to determine Pell Grant Recalculation dates for every semester. The Lake Erie College Financial Aid office considers the status of your enrollment on the semesters' census date, which is at the end of the 100% tuition refund period (three weeks for fall and spring semesters).

A Pell grant may increase or decrease based on changes in enrollment up to the Pell Grant Recalculation or census date.

Federal regulations also require us to recalculate Pell grant eligibility when a student fails to attend any course used to award a Pell grant.
