Note: Graduation rates are provided for  a) Students that declared their major in a specific program by their sophomore year and graduated in that program. b) Students who declared their major in a specific program and graduated in another program within the school of business c) Students who declared their major in a specific program and graduated in any LEC major.  Note: For <u>undergraduate</u> graduation rates, data are provided for full-time incoming students from Fall 2014 who graduated by Spring 2020 in order to include all students that graduated within 4-6 years of entering.	
Graduation Rate (Graduate Program)	Graduation rate is defined as the percentage of a school's first-time undergraduate students who complete their program within 150% of the published time for the program.  For the graduate, two-year degree program, entering students who complete within three years are counted as graduates.
