

GLOBAL GRANT PROGRAMS

In 2015, the MDRT Foundation awarded 218 grants totaling USD 1,262,117 to fund charities worldwide. The MDRT Foundation's grant programs comprise a number of different funds, all of which require the endorsement of a current MDRT member.

Worldwide grants and Quality of Life grants require a grant application submitted by the charity and the member endorsing it. These are reviewed and awarded annually by a committee of MDRT members.

Additional grants programs are defined by Foundation policy and the Board of Trustees. These programs include grants to honor volunteer leaders from MDRT and the MDRT Foundation, charity partnerships in conjunction with MDRT meetings (Annual Meeting, Top of the Table Annual Meeting, MDRT Experience and Global Conference), disaster relief funding and charities in the community of MDRT's international headquarters in Illinois. *For a complete list of 2015 grant recipients, visit mdrtfoundation.org.*

A committee of MDRT members meets in December to review and award grant amounts. Grant recipients are notified in January of the following year.



All grant applications must be completed online. The process is simple and straightforward. The charity representatives should complete the grant writing portion of the application.

THE DREAM CONNECTION

In recognition of his volunteerism with the charitable organization The Dream Connection, the MDRT Foundation awarded

John R. Milam, CLU, the Top Quality of Life Award — an honor given each year to a member dedicated to giving back through volunteer efforts. The MDRT Foundation awarded a USD 50,000 grant to The Dream Connection, which will be used to fulfill the dreams of 20 children dealing with chronic illnesses.

The Dream Connection was founded in 1985, and all programs are led by volunteers who donate their time and skills to help requested dreams come true. Some of the dreams fulfilled by The Dream Connection have included family trips to Disney World, music concert outings, celebrity meetings and shopping trips.

Each year, The Dream Connection fulfills more than 60 dreams for children to share with their families. Many of the children helped by The Dream Connection are dealing with the stress of medical treatments and ongoing hospital stays, so these happy experiences provide a therapeutic outlet and a chance for them to just be a kid.



QUALITY OF LIFE GRANT AWARDS

The MDRT Foundation's Quality of Life program was created to recognize members who volunteer for a charitable organization they are passionate about. In 2015, the MDRT Foundation awarded USD 250,000 to charities in the name of 30 honored member volunteers. The MDRT Foundation bestowed grants to the designated charity in increments of USD 5,000 (24 grants awarded), USD 10,000 (three grants awarded), USD 25,000 (two grants awarded) and one top award of USD 50,000.

PAWS WITH PURPOSE



In 2006, Miles was 6 years old, and his best friend was Faith, a golden retriever provided by Paws With Purpose (PWP), a charitable organization in Louisville, Kentucky, that trains assistance dogs for children and adults with physical disabilities or other special needs.

Miles has Asperger's syndrome, which causes motor skills delays, social skill issues and sensory problems. His new four-legged friend accompanied him on his daily activities and provided a constant support system.

A year after Faith was placed with Miles, his mother began to notice an improvement in her son's life. She wrote a letter to PWP, explaining, "[Faith] has affected everything with Miles. He is trying new things, playing with the neighbor kids, and he is starting to believe that he is a cool kid. Without PWP, I am not sure where we would be with Miles. I know that she has changed our son."

This gift of education allowed Anita to thrive. In addition to getting healthier, she also learned to read and write — something her parents could not do.


Anita is one of 375 young girls who attend this school, which promotes independence and gives hope to students and their families.

MDRT FOUNDATION LEGACY FUND

Bridging the gap between a donor-advised fund and unrestricted charitable giving, the Legacy Fund program allows donors to provide annual guidance to the Foundation's grant-making process in addition to supporting it financially.

Individuals can join the Legacy Fund with an initial contribution of USD 100,000 or a paid-up life policy of at least USD 500,000 to fund annual Legacy grants (minimum USD 10,000) made in their name.

CHARITY: WATER

In fiscal year 2015, the MDRT Foundation partnered with charity: water during the Annual Meeting and the Top of the Table Annual Meeting, raising funds to provide people in Ethiopia and Nepal with access to clean water.

As a result of generous donations from MDRT members, the MDRT Foundation awarded USD 164,084.87 to charity: water to build water projects for families in need. Since its founding in 2006, charity: water has discovered that access to clean water has the power to transform a community by improving health and hygiene, increasing access to education, and advancing economic opportunity.

Tencia's Story

When Tencia's husband died before the birth of their third son, she became the sole provider for her family. As a woman living in an underserved area of Mozambique, Tencia struggled to make her bread-making business sustainable without access to clean water. To get the water needed to make her bread, she would walk for miles to the nearest water supply and have to carry 40-pound jerry cans back to her home.

With the help of charity: water, Tencia's village received a new drilled well that provided a clean and sustainable source of water. "When we were fetching water from the river, it took so much time," Tencia said. "There was no time for other activities. Now we can get water one, two, three, four times from the borehole because it's so close!"

Access to water allowed Tencia to double her production and profits from her bread business, so she can provide for her family and help build a stronger future for her kids.

MDRT FOUNDATION CANADA

MDRT Foundation Canada had an exciting year with many initiatives engaging MDRT members, including a successful holiday campaign and a Valentine's Day online silent auction.

In 2015, MDRT Foundation Canada granted hope across Canada by awarding CAD 73,050 to 19 charities endorsed by members.

As a collective group, our true power is measured by how many people we can uplift — a notion reflected in the continued charitable efforts of MDRT Foundation Canada.



MDRT FOUNDATION JAPAN



In 2015, MDRT Foundation Japan granted a total of JPY 6 million (approximately USD 50,000) to 28 charities sponsored by members in Japan. The Japan chapter chose to support the following charitable organizations for multiple years: Ashinaga Scholarship, a provider of scholarships to children who have lost parents; Child Chemo House, a residential facility for families with children who have pediatric cancer; and Japan Service Dog Association, a service dog training organization.

During the chapter annual meeting in April, MDRT Foundation Japan raised a record high of more than JPY 10 million (USD 82,000) from more than 2,000 members.

On November 21, 61 MDRT member volunteers visited the Ishinomaki district, an area severely damaged by the Great East Japan Earthquake in 2011. Some 50 local kids and their parents, all living in temporary housing, got to enjoy a day at Sendai Umino-mori Aquarium thanks to these volunteers. Another group of member volunteers visited nearly 100 temporary houses to help support elderly residents.

VOLUNTEER SERVICE PROJECTS

The MDRT Foundation develops meaningful volunteer service projects and brings MDRT members together to make a difference for communities in need. By partnering with local charitable community organizations, volunteers get to see firsthand the impact of their investment of time and effort.

In addition to the labor that members selflessly gave, the MDRT Foundation also awarded a USD 10,000 grant to Habitat for Humanity Greater Cincinnati and a USD 50,000 grant to the St. Bernard Project.

In 2015, MDRT members helped build two homes for low-income families in Cincinnati, Ohio.


