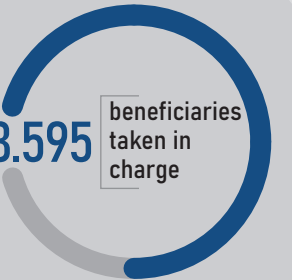
WHAT WE DO
