Schoolies Unearthed Vanuatu



DAY 1: Depart Australia arrive Vanuatu

And we're off! The team will embark on their tropical adventure with their Schoolies Unearthed Leaders. It's just a hop, skip and jump across the Coral Sea to Port Vila, the capital of Vanuatu. The team will be greeted in true Melanesian style, before a short drive out of Port Vila's hustle and bustle, bound for Lelepa Island, its white-sand beaches and clear blue water.

DAY 2: Orientation Day and Explore Lelepa Island

Island life starts today, as the team wake up in their very own paradise, just a coconut's throw from the water's edge. They will get the chance to explore Lelepa, learning about its history and people firsthand. Throughout the day, there'll be all sorts of fun in the sun, including snorkeling, beach BBQ lunch, kayaking, and beach volleyball, Vanuatu's most popular sport after soccer.

DAY 3 - 5: Community Project & Village Homestay

Life on Lelepa revolves around the community. The Schoolies Unearthed team will be able to contribute to this by way of a light construction project. Based on the needs of the village, the team will work with local tradespeople to renovate the women's centre or community hall, build a toilet facility in the primary school or church, or construct a playground in the kindergarten. Throughout the community project, the team will have fantastic opportunities to interact with and get to know their hosts on Lelepa. Whether through spending time with the children and playing games after school, or simply stopping for a conversation in the street, immersion in a foreign environment opens up so many chances for cultural exchange.

DAY 6: Visit Eretoka Island

After a couple of days working hard on the community project, the team will be eager to see more of Vanuatu. Just across the water from Lelepa sits the very distinct Eretoka Island, otherwise known as 'Hat Island' for its jaunty shape. One of the nation's most renowned Warrior Chiefs, Roy Mata, is buried on Eretoka, which has contributed to its UNESCO World Heritage Site status.

DAY 7: Community Project and Cultural Night

Today, the team will continue to push towards completing their project goals, before setting down their tools and preparing for an evening celebrating Vanuatu island life and the cultural beauty of its people. Under the pacific night sky, the village will put on a show and lay out a feast of Melanesian foods for the Schoolies Unearthed travellers. Spoiler alert: there will be dancing!

DAY 8: Visit Port Vila and Explore Efate

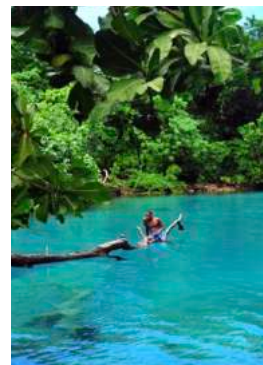
