

# The Importance of Conference of Parties (COP)

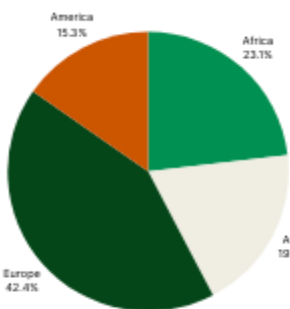
The Conference of Parties (COP) is an essential global platform where countries come together to discuss and address the challenges posed by climate change.
