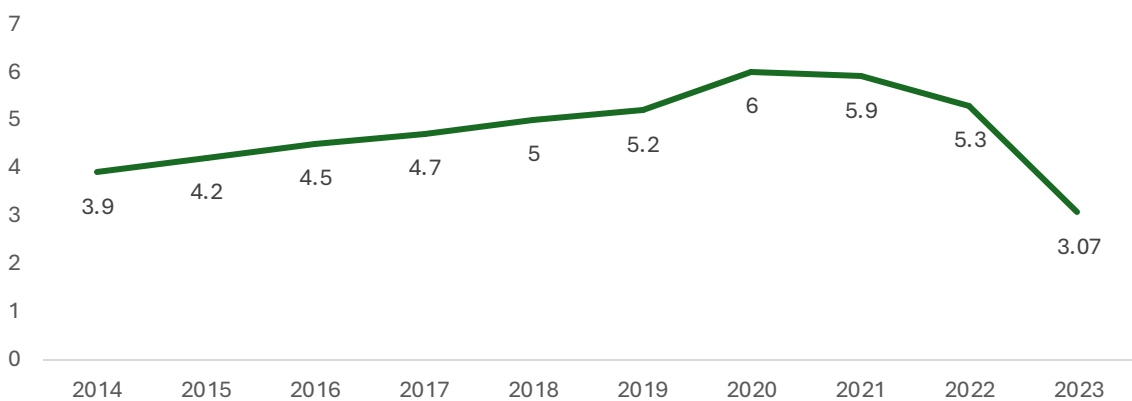

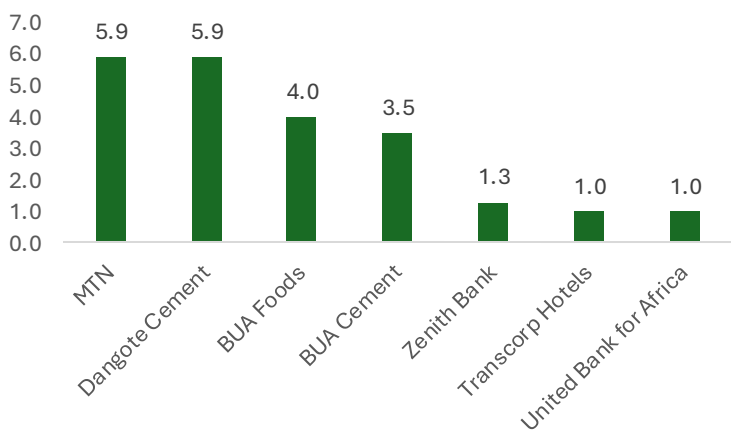
Unemployment rate had been increasing annually for the past decade, but in 2023, it experienced a significant decrease of 0.7%.
