DAY 1 | DUBLIN TO GALWAY

We leave Dublin and head to the **magical Hill of Tara**, once the seat of the High Kings of Ireland. We sample whiskey at Tullamore Dew to get a real taste of Ireland before travelling across the peat bogs and further west to the bustling university town of **Galway**.

DAY 2 | INIS MÓR/CONNEMARA

Cross the Atlantic to Inis Mór for a day to remember. Hire a horse and cart or rent a bike and head back in time and explore this Gaelic-speaking island. From November to mid-April we spend the day exploring **the legendary scenery of Connemara** and visit the magnificent Kylemore Abbey. (B)

DAY 3 | GALWAY TO ENNIS

Explore **the lunar landscape of the Burren** and visit ancient burial tombs before stopping at the **surfing town of Lahinch**. Then on to the **Cliffs of Moher** rising hundreds of feet over the Atlantic Ocean. Overnight in Ennis, where the pubs are filled with locals playing Irish music. (B)

DAY 4 | ENNIS TO KILLARNEY

We travel the **stunning Sleat Head Drive** down to the dramatic Dingle Peninsula; breathtaking scenery, fresh Irish air and the adventures of warriors and heroes. We'll head to the **party town of Killarney** for a night at a Kerry 'dishco'. (B)

DAY 5 | KILLARNEY TO DUBLIN

We enter the rebel County of Cork and head to Blarney Castle, time to get the 'gift of the gab' and kiss the famous stone. We take in the **inspiring Rock of Cashel**, the ancient seat of Kings of Munster, before arriving back to Dublin. (B)

CLIFFS OF MOHER

The Cliffs of Moher are deservedly one of the most visited sites in Ireland. With a sheer drop of over 200 metres to the crashing Atlantic waves below, they offer stunning views of the spectacular coastline. As one of Ireland's top visitor attractions, we've included entrance to the award winning Visitor Centre in our trips.
