DAY 1 | EDINBURGH - LOCH NESS

Leaving Edinburgh we journey north to Macbeth country and visit **picturesque Dunkeld Cathedral**. You have a chance to taste a dram of whisky at a Highland distillery before seeing the ruins of Urquhart Castle. We continue to the **banks of Loch Ness** where we'll spend the night and party till the small hours.

DAY 2 | ISLE OF SKYE

Spend the day exploring the **stunning Isle of Skye** with its myths, legends and faerie stories. Witness the breathtaking mountains, heart stopping cliffs and rugged coastline, before returning back to the mainland past **Eilean Donan Castle - the most photographed castle in Scotland**.

DAY 3 | LOCH NESS - EDINBURGH

Leaving the Great Glen and heading south, we'll encounter the **dramatic mountain scenery in Glencoe** once used as a backdrop in the James Bond and Harry Potter movies. Onward, we **hear tales of William Wallace, Rob Roy and clan battles** before passing Stirling, where the Highlands change back to the Lowlands.
