

Golf Australia National Awards of Excellence

MYGOLF VENUE OF THE YEAR – Selection Criteria & Process

The purpose of this award is to recognise the most outstanding MyGolf Venue based on the quality of the program, participant experience and community impact.

Award Period

• 1 July 2024 – 30 June 2025

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Be officially registered as a MyGolf Centre with Golf Australia during the eligible period.
- Have run at least one full term of sessions within the 12-month award period.
- Be delivered by a registered and accredited PGA Professional, PGA Associate or National Program Deliverer:
- Have a minimum number of enrolled participants, as determined annually by Golf Australia (e.g. 20 participants total across the year).
- Demonstrate growth, retention, or reach into new communities.
- Provide a high-quality experience for juniors and their families.
- The deliverer and host venue must comply with Golf Australia's policies, including Working With Children requirements and codes of conduct.
- The program must not be under any investigation or subject to any complaints that would bring the award or sport into disrepute.

Nomination Process

- Nominations open on: Wednesday 4 June 2025
- Nominations close on: Sunday 13 July 2025
- All nominations must be submitted by 11:59 PM AEST on the closing date. Late or incomplete submissions will not be accepted.
- Nominations may be submitted by club or facility staff, members, volunteers, community organisations, or governing bodies.
- Self-nominations are accepted and encouraged, provided they include supporting documentation/testimonials.

Selection Criteria

The recipient of this award will be selected based on achieving one or more of the following criteria and at the discretion of the Golf Australia National Awards of Excellence Selection Committee:

- Demonstrated success in increasing junior golf participation through program reach, retention, and engagement.
- Implemented an engaging and structured program that fosters skill development, enjoyment, and progression in junior golf.

- Created a welcoming, inclusive, and fun environment that enhances the experience of junior participants and their families.
- Strengthened community connections through partnerships with schools, clubs, and local organisations to expand junior golf opportunities.
- Engagement and alignment with the strategy for Australian Golf 2022–2025.

Supporting Documentation

You may upload up to five (5) supporting documents to assist the selection committee in assessing and comparing nominations, such as:

- a. Photos or videos of the program.
- b. Testimonials (from participants, parents etc.).
- c. Participant numbers or growth data (e.g. term-by-term figures, retention rates).
- d. Promotional materials or community outreach (e.g. flyers, social posts, school engagement).
- e. Program schedule or session plans.

Requirements of Award Recipients

The successful recipients will be required to fulfill the following items upon reasonable request:

- Participate in marketing and promotional activities in the 12 months following the award.
- Participate in Golf Australia pilot programs and initiatives.
