



2022 Greg Norman Junior Masters: State Points Challenge Finals

What is the JGQ State Points Challenge Finals?

This is a **Nett** event that will take place at the Greg Norman Junior Masters. This event replaces the previous Inter-District Teams event but will still have representation from winners within Junior Golf Queensland and District Points Challenge events which have taken place in Queensland throughout the year.

Qualifying juniors who participate in this event, will do so over the first three rounds of the Greg Norman Junior Masters, with the overall winners being announced at Presentations.

How do I qualify for the JGQ State Points Challenge Finals?

Participants qualify through participation in either of the following series:

1. JGQ 18 Hole Points Challenge in South East Queensland
2. District Points Challenge
 - Far North Queensland
 - North Queensland
 - Central Queensland
 - Central Highlands
 - Wide Bay
 - Darling Downs/South West

To qualify and earn your position in the finals, you must win the **overall** (boy or girl) JGQ or District Points Challenge Series that you compete in.

How does the State Points Challenge Finals Work?

- Participants will earn points after Round 1, 2, and 3.
- The maximum number of points that can be earned is 30 (10 per round)
- The points will be based on the **Nett scores** returned by the participants.
- Participants (boy and girl) with the highest number of points after the three rounds will be declared the JGQ State Points Challenge winners.

In the event of ties, the following will determine who the overall winner is:

- The participant (boy and girl) with the highest number of points after round 1 and 2 are combined, will be declared the winner.
