President's Report

The statements and report being considered at the Golf Victoria Annual General Meeting (AGM) on 13 November 2023 cover the full financial year following constitutional change adopted on 5 November 2021 to align Golf Victoria's financial year with Golf Australia (GA)'s financial year. The Golf Victoria financial year commences on 1 July and concludes on 30 June.

On behalf of the Golf Victoria board and its members, I would like to express our gratitude and thanks for the work of Ross Anderson as both a Director and Finance Director. Ross resigned from the Golf Victoria board in May 2023 due to increasing work pressures. Lindsay Holloway agreed to assume the role of Finance Director following the resignation of Ross Anderson. Two casual board vacancies were filled during 2023 and we welcomed Tony Kelly to the board of Golf Victoria, and later in 2023, Steven Craig filled the casual vacancy created by Ross Anderson. Both Tony and Steven, as per the Constitution must stand for re-election at the next AGM after their appointments, which will be the 13 November 2023 AGM.

Cindy McLeish concludes her term due to term limits at the forthcoming AGM and on behalf of the board I would like to acknowledge Cindy on her contribution to Golf in Victoria. Cindy is one of two regional directors on the board, and she has always ensured that regional matters are considered during her time on the board. Thank you to Cindy.

One issue dominated Victorian golf during the latter half of 2022 and 2023 and relate to natural disasters, in particular, floods throughout regional Victoria and in some cases metropolitan Melbourne. To assist with recovery plans, GA provided a disaster recovery kit that included a financial and course assessment of the damage together with de-silting advice. GA also assisted the affected clubs to apply for Government grants to support recovery efforts. I would also like to acknowledge club volunteers and greenkeepers who worked together and donated countless hours to help clean up the flood affected courses.

Victorian club memberships have increased again, but only marginally by just under 1%. This highlights the importance of the current national strategy emphasising 'All Golf is Golf' with a view to better understanding how participants are attracted to golf and the progression from various

versions of the game including mini golf, simulator golf, or hitting balls on a driving range, public course play to eventually joining a golf club.

Across the golfing landscape we need a full range of participants to enjoy the game in all its forms and share that enjoyment with others, as well as ensuring a steady stream of potential club members. One of the more pleasing aspects of the results this year has been the increase in junior memberships with junior female membership increasing by 9.3% and junior male membership increasing by 16.2%. These increases in junior memberships are on the back of significant growth in MyGolf throughout Victoria, with the program reaching 10,000 participants for the first time (10,939) and significantly 2,996 of these participants were female.

The Vic Open was successfully staged with State Government support in February 2023. The event was once again hosted by 13th Beach Golf Links and we thank the board and members for their commitment to the Vic Open format and for making their golf course available. 2023 saw the continuation of the Vic Inclusive Championships, and the playing of the Australian Wheelchair Championships. We congratulate Lachlan Wood on winning the Vic Inclusive Championship, Nick Taylor on going back-to-back and winning the Australian Wheelchair title, and congratulations are extended to Vic Open winners Jiyai Shin and Michael Hendry.

In December 2022, the ISPS Handa Australian Open returned to Victoria for the first time in 20-years and was hosted by the Victoria and Kingston Heath Golf Clubs. We thank the respective boards and members of both clubs for making their golf courses available for the wonderful event that ensued. Taking a lead from the Victorian Open and in a first for national golf opens played around the world, the event brought together the national men's and women's Open events, along with the inspiring All Abilities Championship. The outcome saw an international clean sweep with Adrian Meronk (Men's), Ashleigh Buhai (Women's) and Kipp Popert (All Abilities) lifting the trophies

for the first time. The Championship proved a hit with Australian golf fans, with more than 50,000 spectators lining the fairways at Victoria and Kingston Heath across the four rounds, with considerable television, social and general media coverage also achieved.

Members should also note that the 2022 Australian Open has recognised the innovative contribution of the Vic Open by moving to adopt the same format and include both men and women golfers as well as an all-abilities component to the championships. Golf Victoria should feel proud that the state open has allowed for some innovative thinking that has now been adopted by the national open.

May 2023 saw the annual interstate series played at St Michaels Golf Club in Sydney. The new format adopted for the Interstate Series in 2022 of four men and four women was again very successful with genuine team interactions and great camaraderie between all team members. The Victorian team of Jazy Roberts, Keeley Marx, Amelia Harris, Molly McLean, Jesika Clark, Jasper Stubbs, Connor McDade, Toby Walker, Phoenix Campbell, and Nathan Page won 3 of their 5 round contests, before finishing 4th overall. We congratulate all team members, coaches, and support staff for a wonderful performance.

Sadly, we lost some wonderful contributors to Victorian Golf over the past 12-months also including long serving Victorian Golf Association council members Bob Jolly and George Body.

In October 2022, longtime Chirnside Park General Manager Barbara Kelly and Royal Melbourne Course Superintendent Richard Forsyth were inducted into the Victorian Golf Hall of Fame. In front of nearly 200 people at the Victorian Golf Industry Awards night, both received standing ovations for their incredible contributions to the game for over 30 years.

Achieving closer collaboration and cooperation between Golf Australia, its member associations, the PGA of Australia and the WPGA Tour of Australasia remains a key focus of the national strategy released for golf in Australia in late 2021. The Golf Victoria board was an active contributor to the formulation of the strategy for golf in Australia for the period 2022 – 2025 which adopts a broader remit in relation to the promotion of golf as is indicated by the Purpose, Philosophy and Positioning statements.

The net loss of the company for the financial year after providing for income tax amounted to \$364,588 (2022 \$752,641).

1. Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

This note provides a list of all significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this financial report. These policies have been consistently applied to all the periods presented, unless otherwise stated.

BASIS OF PREPARATION

(i) Special purpose financial report

Golf Victoria Limited (the "Company", "GV" or "Golf Victoria"), a not-for-profit entity, is a company limited by guarantee where, as provided in its constitution, members guarantee its liabilities to the extent of \$10. The registered office of the Company is C/ Golf Australia, Australian Golf Centre, Sandringham Golf Links, Cheltenham Road, Cheltenham Victoria 3192. In the directors' opinion, the Company is not a reporting entity because there are no users dependent on general purpose financial reports.

This is a special purpose financial report that has been prepared for the sole purpose of complying with the Corporations Act 2001 requirements to prepare and distribute a financial report to the members and must not be used for any other purpose.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles of all applicable Australian Accounting Standards and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board and the Corporations Act 2001. It contains the disclosures that are mandatory under the Accounting Standards and those considered necessary by the directors to meet the needs of the members.

The financial report is authorised for issue by the directors on 23 rd October 2023. The directors have the power to amend and reissue the financial report.

(ii) Historical cost convention

The financial statements are presented in Australia dollars, which is the Company's functional currency. The financial report has been prepared on a historical cost basis, unless otherwise stated.

(iii) New standards and interpretations not yet adopted

Certain new accounting standards and interpretations have been published that are not mandatory for 30 June 2022 reporting periods and have not been early adopted by the Company. The Company's assessment indicates that there are no new Australian Accounting Standards or interpretations that have been issued but are not yet effective with an expected material impact on the Company's financial report in the period of initial application.

The principal accounting policies adopted are set out below.

REVENUE RECOGNITION

Revenue is recognised for the major business activities using the methods outlined below.

(i) Government grants

Where Government grants are received with specific performance obligations attached to the grant that stipulate the manner in which the grant is to be acquitted, the entity recognises revenue when (or as) the entity satisfies a performance obligation by transferring a promised good or service to the Government and/or third-party beneficiaries. The grant is recognised in the Balance Sheet as a liability until the conditions attached to the grant are met. Non-Government grants are recognised as revenue when (or as) the entity satisfies a performance obligation by transferring a promised good or service to the third-party beneficiaries.

(ii) Affiliation and membership fees

Affiliation and membership fees are recognised as revenue as performance obligations are met and the service is rendered to members throughout the period.

(iii) Contributions Revenue

Contributions are recognised as revenue when (or as) the entity satisfies a performance obligation by transferring a promised good or service to third - party beneficiaries.

(iv) Interest income

Interest income is recognised as interest accrues using the effective interest method. This is a method of calculating the amortised cost of a financial asset and allocating the interest income over the relevant period using the effective interest rate, which is the rate that exactly discounts estimated future cash receipts through the expected life of the financial asset to the net carrying amount of the financial asset.

(v) Other income

Other income is recognised in the period in which it is received.

INCOME TAX

Golf Victoria is exempt from income tax under section 50-45 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997. Golf Victoria assesses and determines its exemption on an annual basis in accordance with relevant legislation.

IMPAIRMENT OF ASSETS

The carrying values of assets are reviewed for impairment at each reporting date, with the recoverable amount being estimated when events or changes in circumstances indicate that the carrying value may be impaired. The recoverable amount of plant and equipment is the higher of fair valueless costs to sell and value in use. In assessing value in use, the estimated future cash flows are discounted to their present value using a pretax discount rate that reflects current market assessments of the time value of money and the risks specific to the asset. Impairment exists when the carrying value of an asset or cash-generating units exceeds its estimated recoverable amount. The asset or cash-generating unit is then written down to its recoverable amount.

CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS

For the purpose of presentation in the Statement of Cash Flows, cash and cash equivalents includes cash on hand, deposits held at call with financial institutions, other short-term, highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value.

TRADE AND OTHER RECEIVABLES

Trade receivables are recognised initially at fair value and subsequently measured at amortised cost, less loss allowance. Trade receivables are due for settlement no more than 30 days from the date of recognition. Collectability of trade receivables is reviewed on an ongoing basis. Debts which are known to be uncollectible are written off. A provision for doubtful receivable less is established when there is objective evidence that Golf Victoria will not be able to collect all amounts due according to the original terms of receivables. The amount of the provision is the difference between the asset's carrying amount and the present value of estimated future cash flows, discounted at the original effective interest rate. Cash flows relating to short term receivables are not discounted if the effect of discounting is immaterial. The amount of the change to the provision is recognised in the Profit & loss statement. The entity applies the AASB 9 simplified approach to measuring expected credit losses which uses a lifetime expected loss allowance for all trade receivable less and contract assets.

PROPERTY, PLANT AND EQUIPMENT

Property, plant and equipment is stated at historical cost less depreciation. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the items.

Subsequent costs are included in an asset's carrying amount or recognised as a separate asset, as appropriate, only when it is probable that future economic benefits associated with the item will flow to the entity and the cost of the item can be measured reliably. The carrying amount of any component accounted for as a separate asset is derecognised when replaced. All other repairs and maintenance are charged to the profit or loss during the reporting year in which they are incurred.

Depreciation is calculated using the straight-line method to allocate the cost or revalued amounts of the assets, net of their residual values, over their estimated useful lives, as follows:

The assets' residual values and useful lives are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at the end of each reporting year.

An asset's carrying amount is written down immediately to its recoverable amount if the asset's carrying amount is greater than its estimated recoverable amount.

Gains and losses on disposals are determined by comparing proceeds with carrying amount. These are included in profit or loss. When revalued assets are sold, it is entity policy to transfer any amounts included in other reserves in respect of those assets to retained earnings.

TRADE AND OTHER PAYABLES

These amounts represent liabilities for goods and services provided to the entity prior to the end of financial year which are unpaid. The amounts are unsecured and are usually paid within 30 days of recognition. Trade and other payables are presented as current liabilities unless payment is not due within 12 months from the reporting date. They are recognised initially at their fair value and subsequently measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

PROVISIONS

Provisions for legal claims and service warranties are recognised when: Golf Victoria has a present legal or constructive obligation as a result of past events; it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation; and the amount has been reliably estimated. Provisions are not recognised for future operating losses.

Provisions are measured at the present value of management's best estimate of the expenditure required to settle the present obligation at the balance sheet date.

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of associated GST, unless the GST incurred is not recoverable from the taxation authority. In this case it is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of the expense.

Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of the amount of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the taxation authority is included with other receivables or payables in the Balance Sheet.

Cash flows are presented on a gross basis. The GST components of cash flows arising from investing or financing activities which are recoverable from, or payable to the taxation authority, are presented as operating cash flows.

FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS

Golf Victoria's principal financial instruments comprise cash and term deposits. The main purpose of these financial instruments is to finance Golf Victoria's operations. Golf Victoria has various other financial assets and liabilities such as trade receivables and trade payables, which arise directly from its operations. It is, and has been throughout the year under review, Golf Victoria's policy that no trading in financial instruments shall be undertaken.

CRITICAL ACCOUNTING ESTIMATES AND ASSUMPTIONS

The preparation of financial statements requires the use of certain critical accounting estimates. It also requires management to exercise its judgement in the process of applying the Company's accounting policies. There are no areas involving a higher degree of judgment or complexity, or areas where assumptions and estimates are significant to the financial statements.

Following the 2014 State Government Election commitment to provide \$10.0m to fund the construction of a National Home of Golf facility, Golf Victoria Ltd (GV), Golf Australia Ltd (GA), Sandringham Golf Links Management Pty Ltd (SGLM) and the Professional Golfers Association of Australia (PGA) developed a joint project proposal to develop the Sandringham Golf Course as the Australian Golf Centre.

During the period, the final balance of \$44,853 of the State Government project funds has been recognised as grant revenue as GV satisfied its obligations under the grant agreement, being the construction of the asset.

2 (b) Australian Golf Centre Project - Operations Funding

During the period, the sub-lease between Bayside Council, SGLM and Golf Victoria continued under which nominal rent is paid by Golf Victoria for use of the Australian Golf Centre facilities. Separate licences to occupy these facilities conferred on GA and PGA by Golf Victoria, together with the sub-sub-lease between Golf Victoria and SGLM for SGLM's use of the cafe in the facilities, also commenced. Operating expenses referable to these leases and licences and the running of these facilities are paid by GA, PGA and SGLM for Golf Victoria's benefit. During the period, \$259,969 in monies (including

interest) was received with \$258,586 brought to account in accordance with AASB 1058 as contributions revenue and the balance in deferred revenue.

GA, PGA and SGLM have also collectively contributed \$75,000 for a building fund recognised as Deferred Revenue at reporting date. These funds will be recognised as revenue as Golf Victoria satisfies its sub-lease obligations for repairs and maintenance.

2 (c) Grant Revenue - Victorian Programs

Victorian Programs grant revenue is the state government grants received for the Together More Active, Future Healthy and Freestyle Golf Programs. An equal amount was paid to Golf Australia for its operational management of the program under the One Golf Services Agreement and reported as Grant Expense - Other Victorian Programs. Further details of the One Golf Services Agreement are set out in note 13.

1. Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

This is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the requirements of the Trust Deed in the preparation of a financial report. The trustees have determined that the trust is not a reporting entity.

As the trustees have determined that the trust is not a reporting entity there is no requirement to apply applicable Accounting Standards or other authorising pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board in the preparation and presentation of these financial statements.

The financial reports prepared on an accruals basis, based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report:

- (a) Income Tax:** No provision for income tax has been raised as the trust is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.
- (b) Other Financial Assets:** Non-current investments are measured on the cost basis and re-valued according to market value at balance date. Unrealised gains and losses arising from changes in the fair value of investments are recognised in equity in the asset revaluation reserve. Realised gains and losses are recorded in the profit and loss statement as incurred.
- (c) Cash:** Cash includes cash on hand and at banks including at call deposits with banks.
- (d) Trust liabilities and right of indemnity:** The trustees of the VGF act as trustee of a trust and liabilities have been incurred on behalf of that trust. Liabilities incurred on behalf of the trust are not recognised in the financial statements when it is not probable that the VGF will have to meet any of those trust liabilities

from the trust's own resources. When it is probable that the trustees will have to meet some trust liabilities a liability for the Deficiency in Trust Right of Indemnity is brought to account. Details of the trust liabilities, the offsetting right of indemnity, and any deficiency in the right of indemnity are disclosed by way of note to the financial statements.

- (e) Goods and Services Tax (GST):** Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office. In these circumstances the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the assets or as part of an item of expense. Receivables and payables in the Statement of Financial Position are shown inclusive of GST.
- (f)** Income is recognised in the period in which it is received.
- (g)** Cash and cash equivalents and cash on deposit includes cash on hand, deposits held at call with financial institutions, other short-term, highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash.

2. Victorian Golf Foundation (Establishment and Purpose)

VGF was established in 1987. Following an initial period of capital building, the trustees in 1995 commenced making annual allocations and grants to support golf development programs and projects conducted by the Victorian Golf Association, one of the predecessor organisations of Golf Victoria, District Golf Associations, affiliated golf clubs and allied organisations. The process of annual allocations and grants is ongoing and opportunity is provided each year for interested clubs and organisations to apply for funding support. Since 1995 a total over \$5.72 million (2022, \$5.61m) has been expended by the VGF to benefit Victorian golf.

A VGF benefactor program was launched in 1997. Under this program the opportunity exists for any person or group

interested in golf to make single or ongoing donations to assist in further building the foundation's capital fund. Donations are tax deductible as a result of the foundation being registered as an approved project of the Australian Sports Foundation.

For the 12 months ended June 2023 funds were provided to assist the following: golf club memberships, school club linkage programs for juniors, community come and try clinics, scholarships for junior girls, District Association junior clinics and tournaments, MyGolf promotions in schools, golf in primary and secondary school, golf promotion resource materials, and support for regional sports academies.
