Employee or Volunteer Working with Children Clearance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If you intend to only deliver Golf Australia's participation programs through voluntary means at your local golf club and receive no payment, a volunteer Working with Children Check is satisfactory. ○ If you intend to deliver Golf Australia's participation programs at your local golf club or through Sporting Schools where you will receive payment, you will need to ensure you have an employee Working with Children Check. The links below for each state provide information on how to apply, renew or transfer your WWCC.
Pre-requisites	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ WWCC (State/territory guidelines below) ○ Minimum age of 15 years – can provide student card in place of WWCC if under 18* <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - *Please note: check guidelines below to see if you require a WWCC between 15-18 years old in your state/territory - Cannot deliver Sporting Schools programs until 18 years or over and hold a valid WWCC
<u>ACT</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Working with Vulnerable People (WWVP) ○ <u>16 years and over</u> required ○ \$141 application fee for employed, free for volunteers – if volunteering in regulated activity, still need to pay fee ○ Initially receive a card then renewal receipt ○ Registration valid for 5 years
<u>NSW</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ WWCC ○ Exemption if <u>under 18 years</u> ○ Employed is \$80, volunteer is free ○ Online application → service NSW → email notification ○ Online, no physical card, certified through email notification. ○ Registration valid for 5 years
<u>NT</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Ochre Card ○ <u>15 years and over</u> required ○ \$76 for employed, \$7 for volunteers ○ Online application ○ Registration is valid for 2 years
<u>QLD</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Blue Card ○ Exempt if <u>volunteer under 18 years</u>, need Blue Card if paid for work ○ Can only apply if have an agreement to work/volunteer with an organisation → need to have an affiliated golf club fill in application. ○ \$92 for employed, free for volunteers. ○ Teachers receive Blue Card exemption card ○ Blue card is valid for 3 years
<u>SA</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ DHS Screening Unit – 'cleared' ○ <u>14 years and over</u> required. ○ \$119.90 for employed (general), \$65.45 for employed (students), free for volunteers. ○ Valid for 5 years
<u>TAS</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ WWVP card ○ <u>16 years and over</u> required ○ Online but will need to go to Service Tasmania shop to have photo taken

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ \$119 for employed, \$20.40 for volunteer ○ Valid for 3 years
<u>VIC</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ WWCC card ○ <u>18 years and over</u> required ○ Online application but will need to lodge at Australia Post, photo taken ○ \$126.50 for employed, free for volunteers, \$93.60 for renewal. ○ Teachers exempt from check, but must notify WWCC VIC if doing child-related work that is not teaching in school/child-care. ○ Valid for 5 years
<u>WA</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ WWCC card ○ <u>18 years and over</u> required, if being paid require a WWCC if under 18 ○ \$87 for employed, \$11 for volunteers ○ Application form must be lodged at Australia Post, must be signed by a prospective employer or volunteer organisation to confirm work ○ Valid for 3 years
