PRE- OPERATIONAL SAFETY CHECKS

- Read Operators Manual
- Undertake a visual check of the machine.
 - Tyre pressure
 - Fuel Level
 - Engine oil level
 - Check coolant level (DO NOT remove hot radiator cap).
 - Wear appropriate PPE.
 - Check for hydraulic leaks.
- Defective vehicle is not to be used and have a DO NOT USE or similar tag attached until repairs are undertaken.

OPERATIONAL SAFETY CHECKS

- Use care boarding/alighting the machine to avoid slips/trips that could result in injury ensure 3 points of contact and use any steps on the machine.
- The display, no matter who is operating the mower, programs the mowers to mow and turn at exact speeds, to transport at pre-set speeds and to lock in fuel savings.
- Adjust sea and steering column to personal preference.
- Fasten seat belt.
- Start and operate vehicle in accordance with Operators Manual.
- Ensure all safety cut-out switches are operations prior to leaving the maintenance facility.
- Beware of pedestrian and vehicle traffic in the Maintenance facility.
- Observe speed lime in the Maintenance facility.
- Ensure area to be cut is free of obstacles (hoses, hoops etc.), debris and bystanders/Players prior to engaging cutting gear and undertaking cutting task.
- Undertake cutting in the required direction, L/R, R/L etc., and use teardrop or 3 point turns when undertaking direction changes.

Safe Operating Procedure

- ALWAYS be aware of golfers and potential ball strike injury.
- Travel in transport gear, with cutting units raised at a speed appropriate to the conditions and terrain between areas to be cut.
- Exercise caution when operating machine in wet conditions – potential for tyre damage to turf when undertaking turns.
- Vehicle is to be parked with hand brake engaged in neutral gear when alighting mower.
- In the event of a hydraulic fluid leak park the vehicle in that rough as soon as possible, switch off the engine and follow the Hydraulic Fluid Spills Procedure.

ENDING OPERATIONS AND CLEANING UP

- Wash machine in accordance with Machinery Wash Down Procedure.
- DO NOT use hands to turn reels when washing cutting units.
- Vehicle is to be parked in its correct location with handbrake engaged and ignition turned OFF.

MAINTENANCE

- Maintenance must only be performed by qualified personnel in accordance with the Maintenance Section of the Operations Manual.
- This Safe Operating Procedure DOES NOT apply to any equipment that has been modified outside manufacturers specifications.

POTENTIAL HAZARDS AND INJURIES

- Trips/slips with possible muscular skeletal injury when boarding or alighting the machine sue 3 points of contact and steps on the machine.
- i Golf ball strike be aware of golfer whereabouts.
- Muscular skeletal injury if ground speed excessive over uneven terrain.
- Serious injury form rollover on steep terrain or bunker edges.
- Serious digit injury if turning or clearing obstacles from moving reels by hand.
- Serious injury from high pressure hydraulic fluid and burns in the event of hydraulic fluid leak. Potential for fire and burns when refuelling or cleaning up fuel spills.

DO NOT

- DO NOT operate a defective vehicle.
- DO NOT operate this machine without adequate PPE.
- DO NOT exceed speed limit with the maintenance facility confines.
- DO NOT carry passengers on this machine.
- DO NOT permit bystanders to be adjacent to work area when cutting.
- DO NOT operate with fastening seat belt.
- DO NOT leave clippings in heaps in the rough when emptying grass catchers spread them thinly and evenly.
- DO NOT attempt to spin cutting reels or clear obstacles from the cutting reels by hand.
- DO NOT expose unprotected skin to hot hydraulic fluid leaks park mower away from fine cut turf and have repairs effected when fluid cools.
- DO NOT smoke or use mobile phones when refuelling.
- X DO NOT remove hot radiator cap.
